

Glutamic Acid Dehydrogenase Activity Assay kit

GDH (EC 1.4.1.2) is widely distributed in plants and participates in the synthesis of glutamate together with glutamate synthetase (GOGAT). It plays an important role in the metabolism of organic nitrogen compounds.

GDH catalyzes NH4+, alpha-ketoglutarate and NADH to produce glutamic acid and NAD+, causing a decrease in absorbance at 340nm. By measuring the absorbance at 340nm. Calculate the GDH activity as the rate of decrease.
