

Levitide

Levitide has been isolated from skin secretions of the South African frog *Xenopus laevis*. The pyroglutamic acid residue at the NH₂-terminus and the COOH-terminal amide group suggest that levitide may be a neuropeptide or a neuropeptide analog.
