

Human bMSH (beta-Melanocyte Stimulating Hormone) ELISA kit

This kit applies competitive inhibition ELISA method for the quantitative detection of bMSH (beta-Melanocyte Stimulating Hormone) in human samples. The microtiter plate provided in this kit has been pre-coated with Human bMSH protein. Standards or samples are added to the appropriate microtiter plate wells then with a biotin-conjugated antibody specific to Human bMSH. Next, Avidin conjugated to Horseradish Peroxidase (HRP) is added to each microplate well and incubated. After TMB substrate solution is added. The enzyme-substrate reaction is terminated by the addition of sulphuric acid solution and the color change is measured spectrophotometrically at a wavelength of $450 \, \text{nm} \pm 10 \, \text{nm}$. The concentration of Human bMSH in the samples is then determined by comparing the OD of the samples to the standard curve.
