

Mouse IP10 (Interferon gamma Induced Protein 10kDa) ELISA kit

This kit applies sandwich ELISA method for the quantitative detection of IP10 (Interferon gamma Induced Protein 10kDa) in mouse samples. The microtiter plate provided in this kit has been pre-coated with an antibody specific to Mouse IP10. Standards or samples are added to the appropriate microtiter plate wells then with a biotin-conjugated antibody specific to Mouse IP10. Next, Avidin conjugated to Horseradish Peroxidase (HRP) is added to each microplate well and incubated. After TMB substrate solution is added, only those wells that contain Mouse IP10, biotin-conjugated antibody and enzyme-conjugated Avidin will exhibit a change in color. The enzyme-substrate reaction is terminated by the addition of sulphuric acid solution and the color change is measured spectrophotometrically at a wavelength of 450nm \pm 10nm. The concentration of Mouse IP10 in the samples is then determined by comparing the OD of the samples to the standard curve.
