

Porcine HMGB-1 (HighMobility Group Protein B1) ELISA kit

This kit applies sandwich ELISA method for the quantitative detection of HMGB-1 (HighMobility Group Protein B1) in porcine samples. The microtiter plate provided in this kit has been precoated with an antibody specific to Pig HMGB-1. Standards or samples are added to the appropriate microtiter plate wells then with a biotin-conjugated antibody specific to Pig HMGB-1. Next, Avidin conjugated to Horseradish Peroxidase (HRP) is added to each microplate well and incubated. After TMB substrate solution is added, only those wells that contain Pig HMGB-1, biotin-conjugated antibody and enzyme-conjugated Avidin will exhibit a change in color. The enzyme-substrate reaction is terminated by the addition of sulphuric acid solution and the color change is measured spectrophotometrically at a wavelength of 450nm ±10nm. The concentration of Pig HMGB-1 in the samples is then determined by comparing the OD of the samples to the standard curve.
