

Rat IgG1 (Immunoglobulin G1) ELISA kit

This kit applies competitive inhibition ELISA method for the quantitative detection of IgG1 (Immunoglobulin G1) in rat samples. The microtiter plate provided in this kit has been precoated with Rat IgG1 protein. Standards or samples are added to the appropriate microtiter plate wells then with a biotin-conjugated antibody specific to Rat IgG1. Next, Avidin conjugated to Horseradish Peroxidase (HRP) is added to each microplate well and incubated. After TMB substrate solution is added. The enzyme-substrate reaction is terminated by the addition of sulphuric acid solution and the color change is measured spectrophotometrically at a wavelength of $450 \, \text{nm} \pm 10 \, \text{nm}$. The concentration of Rat IgG1 in the samples is then determined by comparing the OD of the samples to the standard curve.
