

Rat PIGF (Phosphatidylinositol-glycan biosynthesis class F protein) ELISA kit

This kit applies competitive inhibition ELISA method for the quantitative detection of Porcine F (Phosphatidylinositol-glycan biosynthesis class F protein) in rat samples. The microtiter plate provided in this kit has been pre-coated with Rat F protein. Standards or samples are added to the appropriate microtiter plate wells then with a biotin-conjugated antibody specific to Rat F. Next, Avidin conjugated to Horseradish Peroxidase (HRP) is added to each microplate well and incubated. After TMB substrate solution is added. The enzyme-substrate reaction is terminated by the addition of sulphuric acid solution and the color change is measured spectrophotometrically at a wavelength of 450nm \pm 10nm. The concentration of Rat F in the samples is then determined by comparing the OD of the samples to the standard curve.
