



Nissl stain solution (toluidine blue method)

Nissl body is a triangular or oval small block substance distributed in the cytoplasm of nerve cells, which can be stained by basic dyes such as thionine, methylene blue, toluidine blue and tar violet. Isochrome dyes reddish-purple to purple-blue. The main advantages of Nissl stain solution (toluidine blue method) are easy operation, stable staining, and wide application range. It can be used for staining Nissl substances and neurons in paraffin tissue sections. It is an important indicator of whether it is damaged. When encephalitis, cerebral ischemia, axonal reaction, etc. occur, Nissl will dissolve or even disappear.
