Alkaline phosphatase (ALP) plays a dual role in immunology: it's used as a reporter enzyme in immunoassays to detect biomarkers due to its high catalytic activity, and it functions as an endogenous anti-inflammatory protein. As a reporter, ALP-conjugated antibodies or antigens amplify signals, increasing test sensitivity.
